Assessment:

Students' ability is gauged both through continuous assessments and a final exam. The continuous assessment component comprises tests/quizzes, mid-semester examination and projects/assignments which accounts for an allocation of about 40-60% marks depending on the course. The balance of the marks is allocated for the final examination.





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
