## Entry Requirements

Pass **Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM)** with a minimum of Grade C (GPA 2.00) in any two (2) subjects or its equivalent and a credit in English at SPM or its equivalent;

OR

Pass **Unified Examination Certificate (UEC)** with at least grade B in five (5) subjects and pass in English Language subject;

OR

Pass **Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM)** with a minimum grade of Jayyid and a credit in English at SPM or its equivalent;

OR

A **Diploma** (Level 4, MQF) with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 or its equivalent and a credit in English at SPM or its equivalent;

OR

**Matriculation/Foundation** with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 or its equivalent and a credit in English at SPM or its equivalent;

AND

A minimum score of 6.0 in **IELTS** or a Band 4 in **MUET** or its equivalent.
