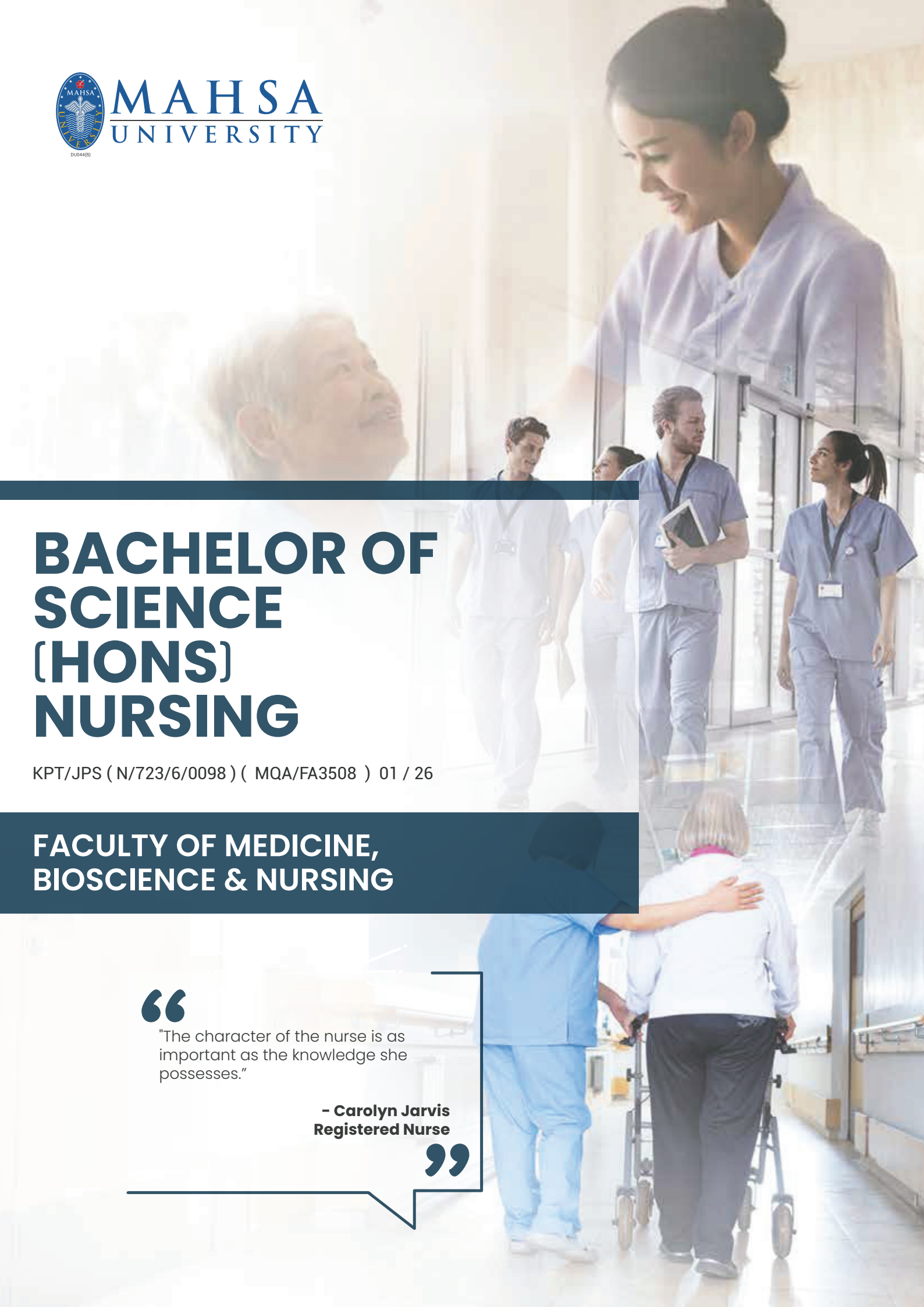

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## OVERVIEW

MAHSA University's Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Nursing is a practical degree programme designed for individuals who are committed to the advancement of the health of individuals, families, communities, and society as a whole.

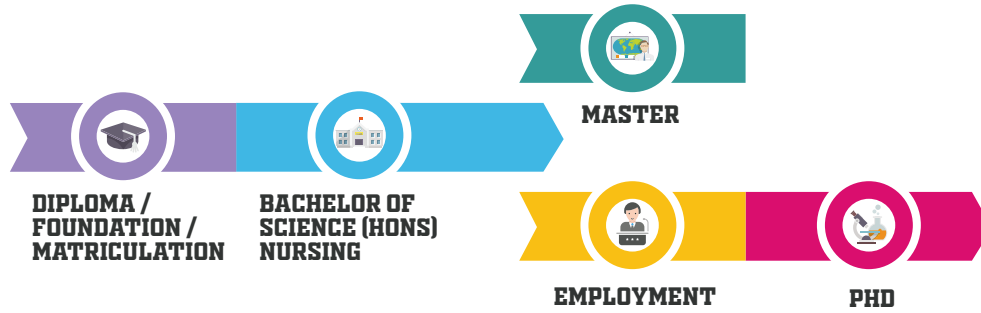

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- SPM** ◆ A minimum of 5 credits in Bahasa Melayu, Mathematics; either 1 of the credits in General Science / Biology / Chemistry / Physics; credits in 2 other subjects & pass English
- STPM / Matriculation / Foundation** ◆ A pass with a minimum of CGPA 2.50
- A-Level** ◆ A pass with a minimum of grade C in 3 subjects
- Diploma** ◆ A pass in any Diploma with a minimum of CGPA 2.50 (*No credit transfer*) Equivalent MQF Level 4.
- Diploma in Nursing** ◆ A pass in Diploma in Nursing from a recognised institution by MNB with a minimum of two (2) years clinical working experience (*Credit transfer allowed*)
- English Requirement** ◆ MUET: Band 3 | TOEFL: 515 | IELTS: 5.5 | SPM: Credit in English

## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All students must be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner within one month from the commencement of the nursing programme

Students must not have any physical disabilities or impaired senses that hinder nursing dexterity

Students with medical conditions such as HIV, AIDS, Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, epilepsy, mental health disorders and colour-blindness cannot be admitted

Due to the potential risks to pregnant women, they will not be considered for this programme

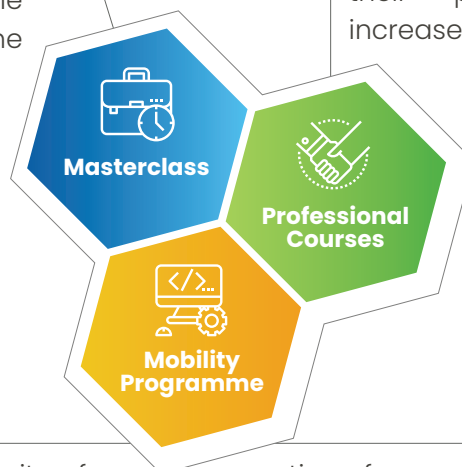
### PROFESSIONAL COURSES

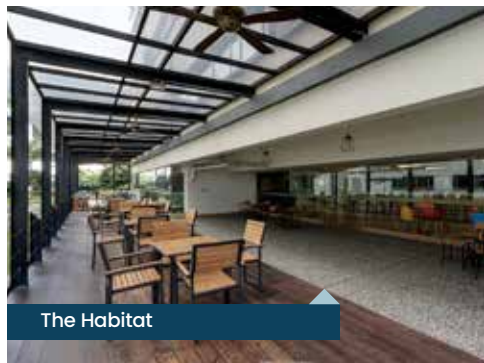
